

## June Curriculum at a Glance:

### Reading Workshop:

In these last weeks of school, we will take time to help the students reflect on the ways they've changed as readers. We will reread favorite books, this time extending conversations and book talks. We will also help the students make plans and develop projects for their summer reading.

### Support our work at home:

Continue to have nightly book talks. Ask questions about your child's just right book that would initiate good conversations. For example:

How does this part make you feel?

What were you thinking?

Do your feelings change during the story? How? Why?



### Writing Workshop:

#### Unit of Study: Independent Writing Projects

In this unit, we will reflect on all the kinds of writing we studied during the year. The children will then select one of those genres to now work on independently.

**Math Workshop:** This month we will be focusing on "Place Value and Fractions". We will also spend time reviewing. Most of the lessons will review different concepts we have learned and give helpful hints.

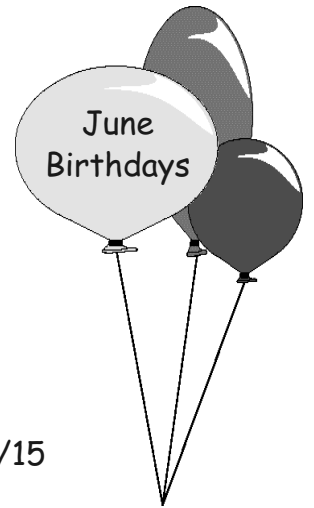
